The undersigned is desired to inform you that the University has considered the Inspection report and approved the proposal for affiliation of Baneswar Sarathibala Mahavidyalaya, Baneswar, Cooch Behar for the academic session 2009 2010 for conducting the B.A. (General) Course in Bengali History English Philosophy and Education with a maximum annual intake of 150 students, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

1. The College shall be guided and maintained by the Act, Statutes, Rules and Regulations of the University of North Bengal.
2. The College may be commenced from the academic session 2009-10 in B.A. (General) Course with Bengali, English, Political Science, History and Education as General Elective subjects and compulsory papers as per University Norms.
3. The Syllabi of the proposed course shall be according to those prescribed by the University of North Bengal.
4. The College Authority shall expedite to take steps to move the Government to get Teachers and Principal to the respective substantive posts duly recommended by College Service Commission in the general interest of Higher Education of the region.
5. The College shall have to appoint full time employees within the month of September, 2008. The College Authority shall expedite to take steps to move the Government to get employees through the Employment Authorities as per rules.
6. The institution may, at present, start functioning at the identified school premises. However, the teaching hours (6 hours) including College administrative hours (8 hours) as stipulated by the norms of the University shall be strictly complied with.
